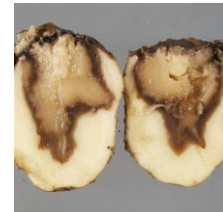

What are classified seed potatoes?

These are potato tubers carefully grown and selected for size, minimum pest and disease levels by specialised commercial growers using a time evolved scheme supervised by government inspectors. **For these 3 severe diseases there is zero tolerance.** The potatoes can then be legally sold to commercial growers and gardeners for planting.
